Dr. Mark Lyons, global vice president and head of Greater China at Alltech, obtained his undergraduate

He then completed a master's degree in brewing and distilling in 2001, followed by a Ph.D in the area of solid state fermentation (SSF) with Heriot Watt University, Edinburgh.
